2015 STUDENT OUTCOMES

To help the community during their decision-making process, we are sharing the following outcome rates and other school information as reported to our accrediting agency, the State of California, and the U.S. Department of Education, respectively, for students scheduled to graduate during the year 2015.

NACCAS' Placement Rate is based on graduates employed in a field for which their training prepared them prior to November 30, 2016. Exclusions are graduates who are deceased, permanently disabled, deployed for military service/duty, studied under student visa and is ineligible for employment in the U.S., or continued his/her education at an institution under the same ownership. NOTE: being unlicensed in not a valid exclusion.

³ Because of the change in the Bureau's reporting regulations, which became effective on July 14, 2016, this institution was not required to collect the data for its 2015 and prior graduates.

BPPE's Placement Rate is based on graduates employed in a single position for which the institution represents the program prepares its graduates within six months after the first examination results after the student completes the applicable educational program. Exclusions are graduates that have died, became incarcerated, were called in to active military duty, were international students that left the United States or did not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.
